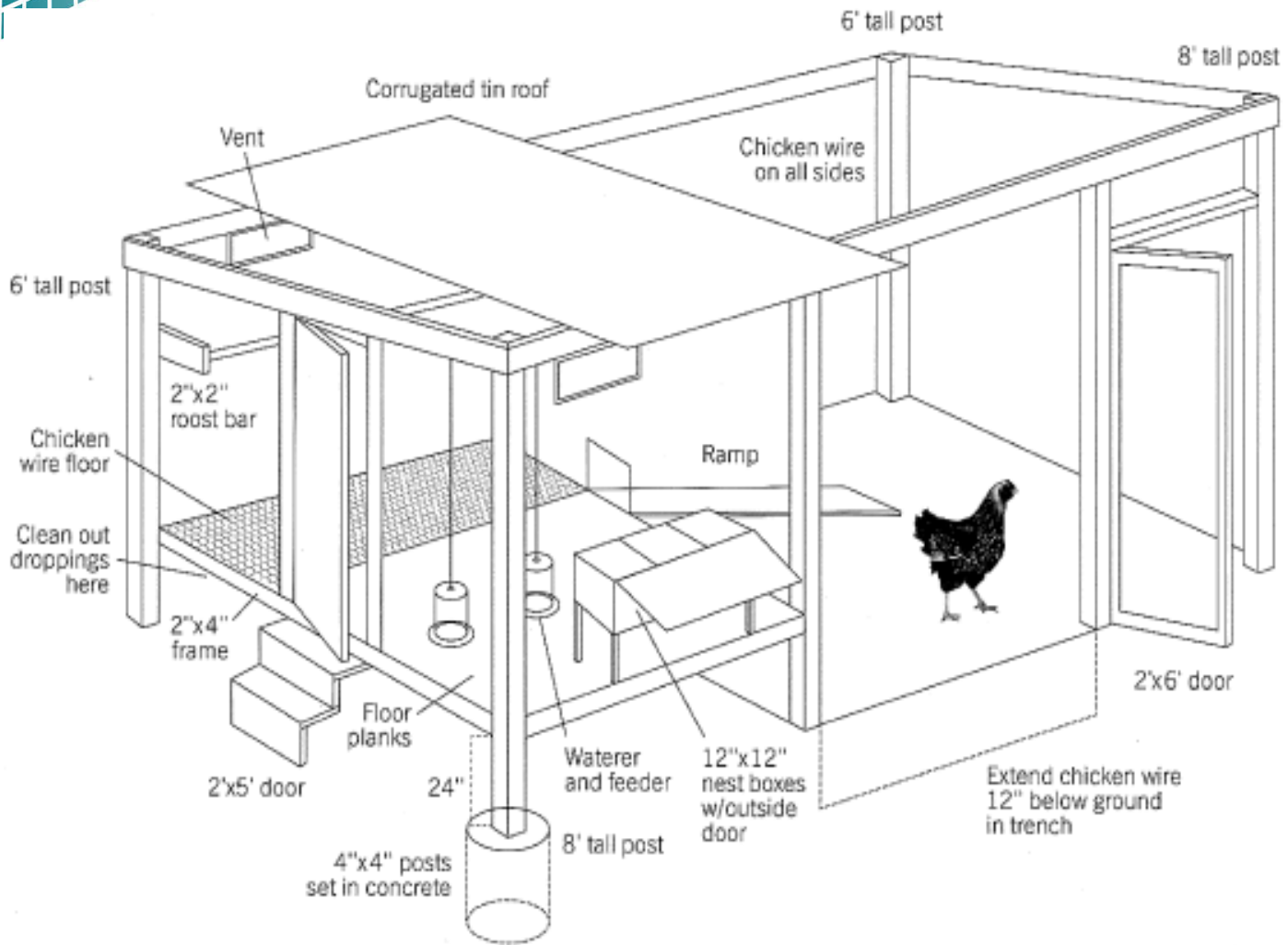

Specifications vs. Scope of Work

Specification

- A “precise” description of requirements
- Provide physical, technical, or functional characteristics
- Provide quality or performance parameters
- Allow for competitiveness (*VPPA*)
- Enhance competition (*VPPA*)



Scope of Work/Purchase Description

A description of work to be performed, typically broken out into specific tasks with deadlines.

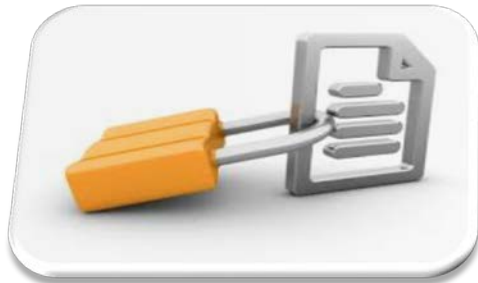
Categories (APSPM,4.4)

Teams:

- should actively participate

Teams shall complete Task 1 within 15 minutes.

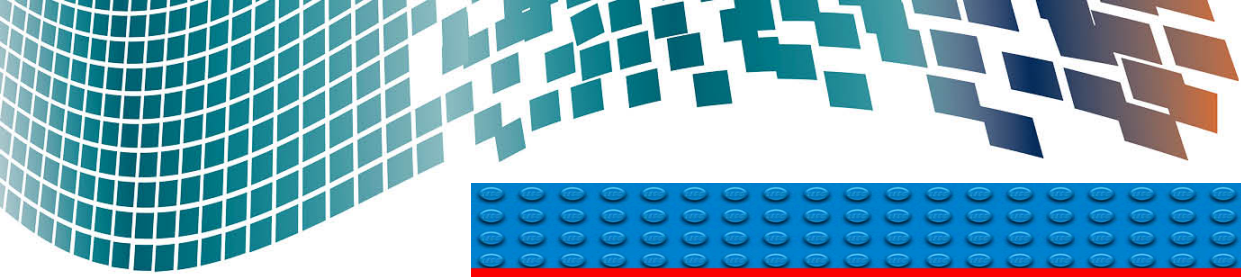
The specifications will be delivered for the design phase. The team shall construct a “model” by use of the specifications provided. ALL Terms and Conditions shall apply.
