





Listening for communication

"If we were supposed to talk more than we listen, we would have two tongues and one ear." - Mark Twain



- Stop talking
- Focus on the person speaking
- Put the speaker at ease/show empathy
- Watch for nonverbal cues
- Paraphrase the message to confirm your understanding
- Ask clarifying questions








Instructions

Top 10 Tips for Effective Communication

- 1. Build the relationship first
- 2. Set the stage for communication
- 3. Know what you want to say
- 4. Tailor your message to your audience
- 5. Watch your body language and voice inflection
- 6. Be brief and specific
- 7. Listen more than you speak
- 8. Focus on understanding yours and theirs
- 9. Avoid fillers
- 10. Practice!
