We evaluate federal property from DRMO'S. We take in property for example; end loaders, dump trucks, generators, airport tugs, small cranes and furniture.

- Chapter 12 of the APSPM
- Transfer within the same agency.
- Transport property to a warehouse .

- Service charge to other agencies, localities or qualified non-profit organizations

Internet Sales

Surplus Property Report

- Give a full description of the item for example : color, model, year, condition and quantity. Also any remarks such as dimensions and weight.
- The more information you provide the less questions you will receive once advertised.



Internet Sales

Sell property in place (no transportation cost)

Agencies will receive a percentage of the revenue.

Access DGS 44-001 form (Netsales (DGS) NetSales@dgs.virginia.gov)

DGS posts items, collects transactions and answers any concerns or questions.

Buyers makes arrangements to collect the item.



Internet Sales

Surplus Property Photo's

- Take as many digital photo's as you can of the item and save to a jpg format.
- Email Surplus Property Report with the photos of the items being sold.
- When a bidder has won the item DGS has a new payment portal in which we will send payment instructions along with a payment receipt.
- DGS Fiscal will electronically transfer payments received throughout the month.

Surplus Property Disposal

Major Relocation Projects

- Contact Surplus Property early in the planning stage of your relocation (3-6 months in advance)
 - Prepare a general list of expected property
- Schedule a meeting with the surplus property on site.
 - Be sure to include a timeline upon removal.
- Surplus Property will assist in answering any questions or concerns about the items



Recycling

- Printer Cartridge Recycling

You can now recycle printer cartridges through the Surplus Property Office of the Virginia Department of General Services.
